Proposed Policy Resolutions

State Policies

- 1. We support agricultural assessment on all acreage used by any farm operation exceeding **\$10,000** \$50,000 in sales. (Current policy #19 on page 2 in section on Agricultural Assessments, new laguage in bold and underlined)
- 2. We support extending the 10-year Real Property Tax Exemption (RP-483) for newly constructed or reconstructed agricultural structures.
- 3. We support prohibiting the use of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV'S) for the hunting of wildlife, but support an exemption for their use in filling DEC nuisance permits.
- 4. We oppose any attempt to create a state standard for a "pollinator friendly solar array", as a means to allow developers to receive tax credits.
- 5. We support ensuring that farm brewery licensees comply with the provisions to use New York State grown products, as noted in the existing statute <u>and further support the development of an on-line annual compliance/audit report for the licensees to complete that ensures that the provisions of the statute are being met.</u> (Current policy #15 on page 39 in the section on Brewery and Distillery Issues, new language in bold and underlined)
- 6. We do not support a re-establishment of the New York State Barn Restoration and Preservation grants program.
- 7. We support establishment of line item funding in the NYS Budget for the New York State Agricultural Mediation Program.
