## BILL: NYFB's arguments carry the day after heated debate in the State Senate

Never mind that the fight has largely been one where the issue — improvements to farm workers lives and working conditions — won't be positively impacted by the legislation that's being pushed. And that was a point that was brought out successfully on the floor of the State Senate around 9:30 p.m. after a day when, just in the morning hours, the newspapers were reporting that there would be no Senate vote on the state budget as Sen. Espada was refusing to come to town to provide the necessary 32nd vote for a majority.

Sitting in the galleries of the Senate Chamber during the labor debate were Jeff Williams and myself, while hundreds of farmers were tuned to their computers watching the live action through the web. Also sitting in the galleries were representatives from the corporate unions, NYS United Teachers, Rural and Migrant Ministries and several college kids wearing red T-shirts. Which way would the vote go, and how long would the debate last?

After spending so much time on this issue over the past decade, but really seeing the efforts to pass the bill come to a head during 2010, I wasn't entirely sure myself what the outcome would be. But I knew that our farmer members had done the best job possible in spending time educating their elected officials, and as many downstaters that would listen, on the issue.

The opening comments were instructive, as Sen. Espada began the debate seeking to prove that he was out to save the farmworkers from repression and to bring justice and honor the legacy of Caesar Chavez.

Sen. Catharine Young, R-Olean, leaped in, as she has so many times over the past two years, quickly pointing out that the rhetoric used by opponents on this issue was proven to be false during a Senate Agriculture Committee hearing on the topic in March.

Sen. Dale Volker, R-Depew, a retiring

Senator from Western New York and a great friend to farmers over the years, provided a statesmanlike overview of the issue.

Sen. Michael Nozzolio, R-Fayette, from the Finger Lakes area, pointed out the facts surrounding farm labor, including the wide variety of federal laws, the global marketplace that exists in agriculture and the lack of these mandates on farms in other states.

Sen. William Larkin, R-Cornwall, while questioned several times by Sen. Espada, more than held his own, talking about the many farms he has visited in his home district in the Hudson Valley.

Sen. Larkin eloquently relayed an experience he had while speaking to workers on an apple farm. The workers indicated that their families will all have better lives from the money made while working in agriculture — jobs that wouldn't be available at the same pay scales should the farm labor mandate bill pass. Many other Senators from farm country spoke about the negative impact of the bill on farmers, farmworkers and their respective families. Sen. Owen Johnson, R-Babylon, from Long Island, talked about how he grew up on a dairy farm and understood that cows don't take breaks over the holidays, while Sen. Stephen Saland, R-Poughkeepsie, also expressed his serious reservations about a bill that sounds good on the face of it, but in fact hurts the very people it aims to help.

Sen. Darrel Aubertine, D-Cape Vincent, spoke about the importance of the dairy economy in New York and particularly in the North Country, and about how farmers have been enduring difficult times — cutting family expenses, even dropping health insurance — but the farm employees are always paid, as opposed to having lay off's, because that's just the right thing to do and the way farms are run.

The infuriating aspect of watching a debate, without being allowed to speak, happens when the representatives supporting this bill have their turn. Sen. George Onorato, D-Queens, the chairman of the Labor

Committee, took his turn to list off, incorrectly, states that have "similar laws." What he failed to disclose was that among the listing, no state except California has the level of comprehensive mandates contained in Sen. Espada's proposal. A few states do have different overtime rules (none as strict as California's or Sen. Espada's proposal). A few have unemployment insurance and collective bargaining and housing provisions, but none have the comprehensive layer of mandates and cost that the bill being debated would have imposed on the farm community.

In fact, the governor of California, not less than a week prior, had vetoed legislation that would have tightened California's farm labor overtime law even more, stating that California agriculture depended upon factors like the weather that didn't make it conducive to take the overtime law for farmworkers from 60 hours a week to 40.

Sen. Eric Schneiderman, D-Manhattan, stood up to deliver a ringing floor speech about how he supported the bill from a justice framework, because since the days of the Republic's formation the founding fathers like Thomas Jefferson had fought for equality and it was necessary to live up to the Jeffersonian ideal. What he failed to mention is that Thomas Jefferson, while a vital figure in our nation's history and our third President, as an actual slave-owning plantation owner believed in equality largely for white male property owners.

The vote record is published on the front page. Please take a look as the representatives who voted "nay" truly voted to keep families farming in New York. They had the political courage to vote with their convictions, to vote against the pernicious influence of unions and rhetorical fear mongering. Please also spend time in thanking Senators Aubertine and Young, whose leadership and bipartisan cooperation to help ensure the future of farming in New York was unparalleled. Nobody thinks this issue has gone away completely,

but perhaps we can spend our time now working on policies that help, rather than harm.

We have the luxury as a society to be almost completely divorced from the realities of food production, largely because we have efficient farmers who care about what they do, and do not generally see an adequate return on investment. But this failure to re-connect with our food, and to try to impose moral or value judgments about farming, will be a trend which NYFB and our farmers will have to contend with for many years to come, unless, or until, we see food shortages in this country and food scares from abroad.

And perhaps the optimistic view is warranted, that we've made some headway in educating the legislators and the public about how important it is to take the time to understand that if we're going to keep a local food system, we have to keep our local farmers, and their employees, farming.
