There is hope that given the passage of both the House and Senate Farm Bill that Congress will be able to agree to a final version that the President will sign before the Sept. 30 deadline.

House Agriculture Chairman Mike Conaway has a countdown clock on his phone and is optimistic that the bill will be done on time. Members of the House are expected to leave for their August recess on July 27 and won't return until Sept. 4. The Senate has indicated they will stay in town for part of the August recess to work through nominations. It is expected that talks will occur on language to include in the bill and that when members return in September, negotiations will continue on the bill.

The toughest issues for negotiators will be to resolve the differences in the Nutrition Title. The House version expanded work requirements for the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, while the Senate made minor changes. There are also differences in the Conservation Title, with the House eliminating the Conservation Stewardship Program (CSP) and increasing funding in the Environmental Quality Incentive Program (EQIP). The Senate does not eliminate CSP. There are also differences in the Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) in terms of rental rates and total acreage under the program. There are also minor changes in other titles of the bill that will need to be sorted. agenda, including efforts to undo the Clean Power Plan and the Waters of the U.S. rule. Wheeler has extensive experience with environmental and regulatory policy, having served as special assistant in the EPA's toxics office during President George H.W. Bush's administration and as a top staffer on the Senate Environment and Public Works Committee and as a longtime aide to Sen. James Inhofe (R-OK).

Trade Concerns Continue

Negotiations on NAFTA continue as Mexico has elected a new president, Andrés Manuel López Obrador and U.S. officials have met with the Mexico President to discuss terms of the trade agreement. It is rumored that the U.S. might finalize a trade agreement with Mexico

separately from Canada. Dairy continues to be a sticking point in the U.S. - Canada talks.

Retaliatory tariffs from Canada, Mexico, the EU, and China have gone into effect and the impacts are starting to roll in. The new forecast for exports in the department's World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates (WASDE) report shows U.S. soybean exports at just 2.04 billion bushels, down from the June forecast of 2.29 billion bushels. Brazil's exports, on the other hand, were raised 3 percent. The USDA lowered by 75 cents a bushel its forecast for the average farm-gate price on this year's soybean crop. The average price is now executed to be about \$9.25 a bushel.

The USDA has stated that it is working on a support program for farmers that have been impacted by retaliatory tariffs but no final details on the program have been released. Many agricultural organizations are taking the stance of "trade before aid," in the hopes that trade talks can work out tariffs instead of providing payment assistance to farmers.
