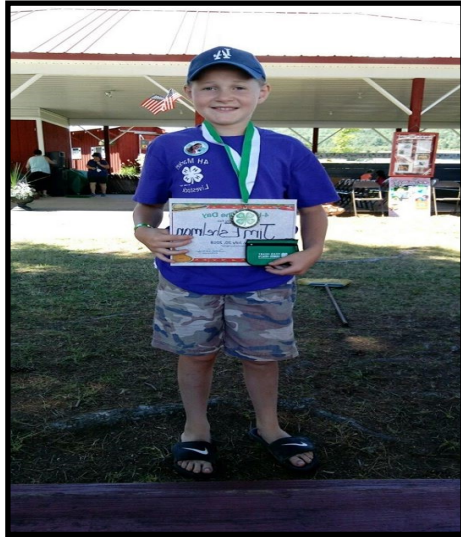


Highlights of the Fair
