2020 MADISON COUNTY PROPOSED POLICY RESOLUTIONS

Please review the resolutions below for the upcoming Madison County Farm Bureau Annual Meeting being held on Oct. 10. These resolutions are a jumping off point for discussion. Feel free to bring your own suggestions and unique ideas to the meeting.

STATE RESOLUTIONS

- 1. We support allowing semi-trailers (over the road tractors) being able to be registered as agricultural vehicles by farmers.
- 2. We support efforts to create a cost-share program through the Department of Agriculture & Markets in relation to assisting livestock producers with the implementation of electronic livestock identification.
- 3. We support line-item funding in the New York State budget for a New York State hops specialist through Cornell University. (reaffirmation of current policy #24 on pg. 51, section on Farm-Based Beverages)
- 4. We support line-item funding in the New York State budget for the Northeast Hop Alliance to assist with the promotion and marketing efforts of New York Hops and New York brewed beer.

NATIONAL RESOLUTIONS

- 1. We support allowing food banks and other organizations using milk vouchers through the Milk Donation Program as authorized in the 2018 Farm Bill as a tool to help move milk through the food donation system.
- 2. We support the creation of an indemnity program for producers that would cover the loss of crops and livestock due to pollution from PFOA and PFAS substances. The funding should come from EPA Superfunds or the Department of Defense, depending on the source of pollution.

INTERNAL RESOLUTIONS

1. We encourage the New York Farm Bureau Board of Directors to lead an effort to secure line-item funding for the Northeast Hop Alliance in the New York State budget.
