I'm pleased to announce that the Yates County Farm Bureau **Tools of the Trade** matching grant scholarship is now available. The application is provided inside this newsletter. Please feel free to share with

anyone between the ages of 17 and 35 interested in pursuing a career in a skilled trade or looking to enhance their career and skill set right here in Yates County. Yates County Farm Bureau members applying for this scholarship can receive a matching grant of up to \$650 per year. Non-members can be eligible to receive up to \$500 per year. Applicants can reapply yearly, and applications are accepted yearround.

This scholarship would not have been possible if not for the support of donors, sponsors, and attendees of our recently held **Tools, Trades and Trivia Event** in April. We had almost 120 people that attended with loads of items donated for auctions and many that opened up their wallets for the support of this scholarship. We look forward to building on the enthusiasm from our first **Tools, Trades and Trivia Event** with future events scheduled as we seek to expand the workforce of the skilled trades in Yates County, so stay tuned!
