vibrant agricultural sector.

Our policy positions start with you, as you air your concerns at the annual policy picnic on July 27. Issues raised at the picnic work their way up the ladder, to the tri-county and state annual meetings. Once adopted, by a majority vote, our policy is presented to legislators in Albany and Washington, or at the local level.

The recently passed inherent risk bill is a perfect example of how Farm Bureau's persistence pays off. On my first visit to Albany as a Farm Bureau delegate in 2002, the idea that equine and pick-your-own operations should be protected from frivolous lawsuits seemed far-fetched. Now it's a signature away from becoming law. We are currently working on many other farm-friendly bills, including legislation to defray the high cost of employee's salaries, and adjustments to the Food Safety Act.
